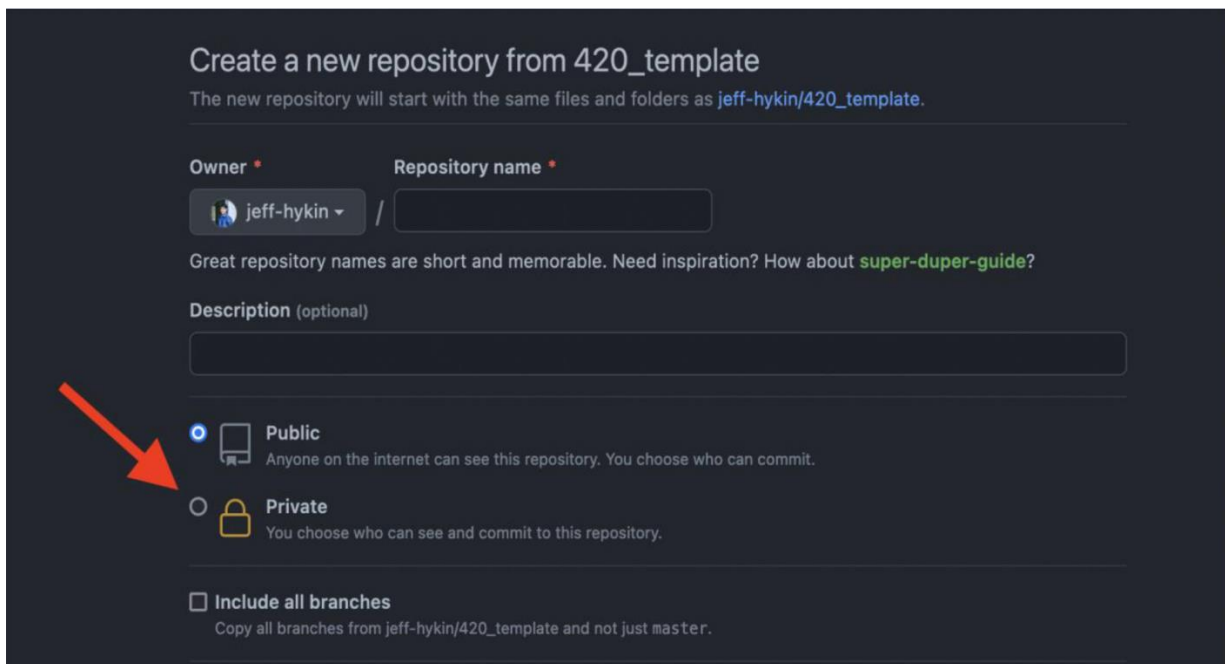
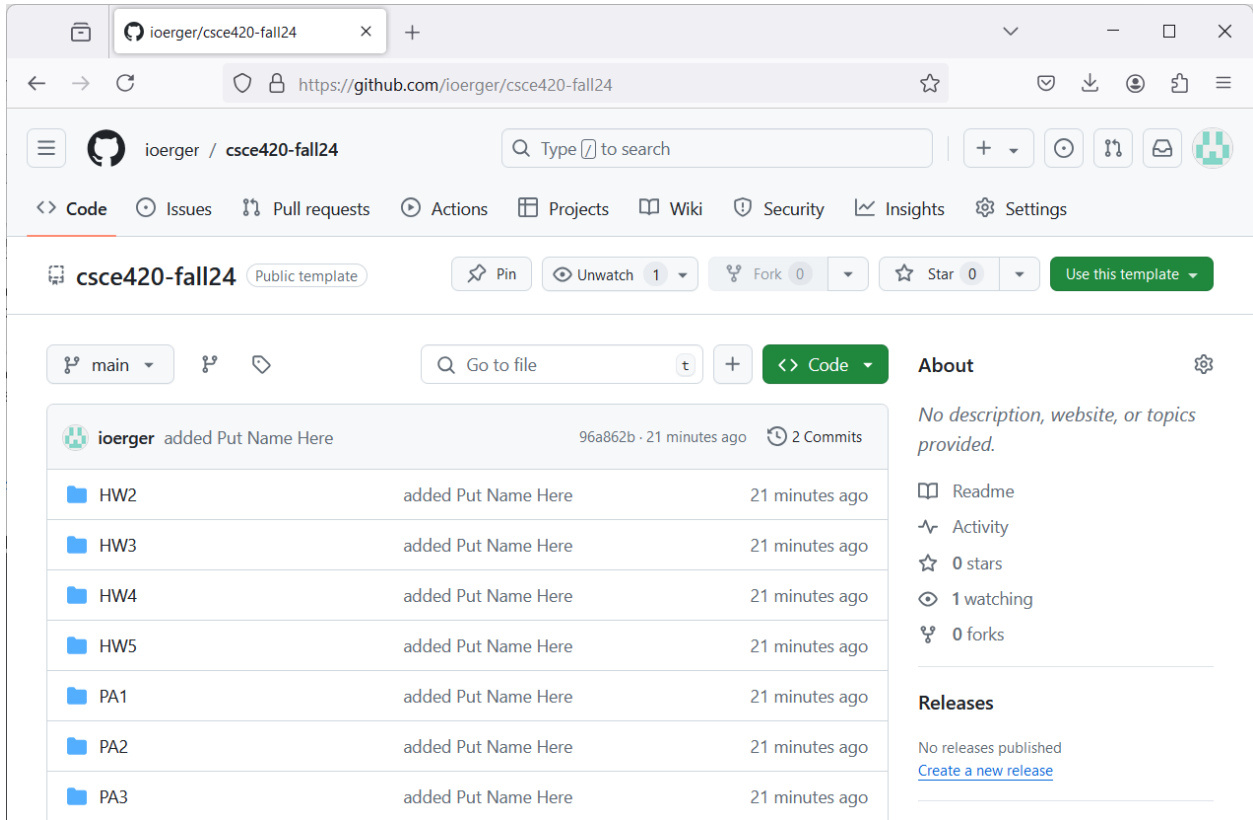
### Objective

All you need to do for this homework is create a private Github repository that will contain all your projects and assignments for this course, and add the professor and TA as collaborators.

### Instructions

1. **Login to your github account.** You should have a TAMU-associated github.com account, which allows you to maintain private repositories for free.
2. **Open the project template** <https://github.com/ioerger/csce420-fall24> This is pre-formatted with empty directories for each of the homeworks and programming assignments this semester.
3. **Create your own repository from this template** by following these instructions: <https://docs.github.com/en/repositories/creating-and-managing-repositories/creating-a-template-repository> (see screenshots below)
4. **Make your repo Private.** (by setting visibility to Private while creating the repo, or in Settings, under 'Change repository visibility' afterwards)
5. **Edit your name into the README.md file in the top directory.** Commit and push the change in your repo.
6. **Add the instructor and TA as collaborators.** Under 'Settings' and 'Collaborators', click 'Add People' and add each of the following email addresses (one at a time).
